













Youth Ambassador Guide

-  **Apply:** Fill the form on our website, and choose a slot for the interview call.
-  **Interview:** Applicants will receive a call from their City Coordinators for a telephonic interview. If selected, the selection email will be sent from ICCE along with the credentials to access the My Account page.
-  **Login to My Account:** All the required documents related to the Program along with e-posters for promotions and registration form will be available on My Account Page.
-  **Spread the Word:** Gather participants for the program by explaining the benefits. Educate people about the need to be aware about our Indian Constitution and Judicial System.
-  **Weekly Report:** Every Monday a weekly report has to be filled and submitted to the respective City Coordinator.
-  **Your Rebate:** Rebate of Rs. 50/- per registration (i.e. approx. 6.5% per participant) for 24 registrations is provided. On submission of more than 24 registrations, the rebate would be doubled to Rs. 100/- per Registration (i.e. approx. 13% per participant). The rebate amount can be retained or used for administration purpose.
-  **Submit Registration:** Collect fees, fill the Registration form and submit it within 30 days from the date of selection.
-  **Distribute Material:** Once the form and fee is received; the Social Law Program Course Materials will be delivered within 10 working days. Consignment details will be shared via email.
-  **Rights to Rise:** As a part of the Program, Rights-to-Rise activity is performed. The participants promote the Pocketbooks provided and educate people about individual rights and responsibilities as an Indian Citizen. Pocketbooks are promoted for Rs. 25/- each. The funds collected are to be deposited with ICCE for Social activities. Non-completion of the activity would affect the grades of the Participant. Grades are credited on the number of Pocketbooks promoted.
-  **Exams:** Assessment will be through Online exams per group. The test will contain Objective type questions & scores will be awarded. Similarly A+, A, B+ & B Grades will be provided for the Rights-to-Rise activity.
-  **Certificates:** Social Law Program Certificates will be sent to the Youth Ambassadors after the completion of the Program.
